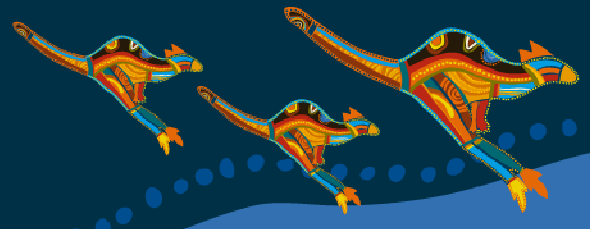

### Expansion Plans

At the moment work at the Tanoa Tusitala is still in progress and hoping to open around June or August 2010 if everything goes to plan. After opening the Tanoa Hotel in Samoa, the expansion work will begin for Tanoa Suva. The next project which is Tanoa Tower will comprise of 68 bedrooms, conference facility with 500 sitting and expansion of the carpark.



## Investment Plans

- The Tanoa Hotel Group is expanding its business in the Pacific with the recent purchasing of Apia's *Hotel Kitano*. The purchase in Samoa will complement operations in Fiji, New Zealand and Vanuatu. The Kitano will undergo a major transformation as a result of a multi-million dollar reinvestment program in operational & public areas.
- The Group also acquired the *Russell Cottages* complex in Russell, New Zealand. The Russell purchase may lead to further purchases in New Zealand, Fiji, Vanuatu & Samoa.
- Future investment in the hospitality industry in Samoa and other options were also being actively considered.

## Other Services

### HR Development

The Tanoa Hotel Group has teamed up with a leading international professional training and personnel development provider to create Fiji's first Hotel Training School. This has been achieved by transforming the Tanoa Hotel Raki Raki into a hotel training school initially for Chefs, Food and Beverage Service staff, Housekeeping personnel and eventually Front Office staff.

Tanoa Hotels is keen to work with USP, TPAF and FIT in the development of their own training programmes and see immense advantages in exposing students to this hotel training environment.

The Training Facility opened in late January, 2009 and will operate for some 44 weeks. The majority of students will initially be from the Pacific region including students from Fiji as well as Kiribati, Tonga, Tuvalu and the Solomon Islands.
