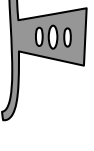
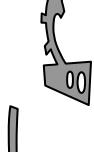
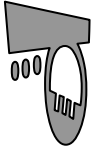




Export Celebrity Heads

Globalisation Category Challenge

Years 7 and up

The teacher will divide you into groups of four. Come up with a team name and write it on the board.

The teacher will give you a sheet of butcher's paper and some textas. Write the following headings related to globalisation on your sheet of paper:

- New technologies assisting globalisation
- Trans-national or multinational companies
- International organisations
- Australian agricultural exports
- Global media networks

In twenty minutes write as many relevant things under each heading as possible.

When time is up, the teacher will ask each team to read out its items under each heading, and teams will receive points for the following:

- 5 points for being the team with the most items under one heading
- 1 point for each item that other teams missed

The teacher can discount an item if it does not fit under that heading.
