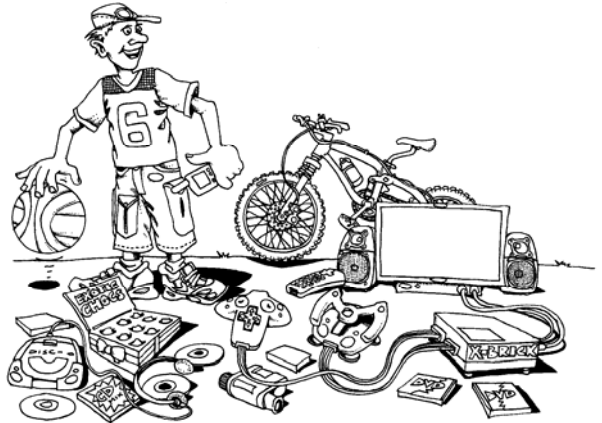




International Trade at My House

Australians buy many things that have been made in other countries (imported goods) and sell many things that have been made in Australia to people in other countries (exported goods).

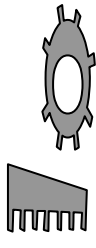
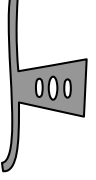
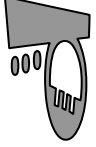
Take this sheet home and investigate your house to find imported goods. Fill in the table with your results.
