



# Procurement Opportunities in Infrastructure - Indonesia

## ABOUT KIAT

KIAT is a partnership between the Governments of Australia and Indonesia to support sustainable and inclusive economic growth through improved access to infrastructure for all people.

KIAT works with government and civil society, providing technical assistance to improve infrastructure policy, planning and delivery. KIAT also works with sub-national governments to improve the quality of infrastructure spending and planning.

KIAT regularly procures services – including management, engineering, research and technical advice - to implement large and small projects related to transport, water and sanitation, energy, private sector engagement and gender equality and social inclusion.

## Up to A\$25 million infrastructure opportunities per year

KIAT works with its government partners across Indonesia to deliver a range of large and small projects to improve access to infrastructure for all Indonesians. KIAT is seeking expertise across the project life-cycle, awarding contracts to conduct:

- **Scoping** – exploring existing and new engagement areas to identify constraints and opportunities for potential KIAT support and partnerships;
- **Analytical work** – reviewing existing legal, regulatory and policy options to inform government decision-making on improving infrastructure;
- **Feasibility studies** – assessing the practicalities of different engineering solutions to improve infrastructure and help identify the optimum solution;
- **Design** – detailed engineering design work for projects that have secured public and private financing for implementation;
- **Project management** – working with partners in planning and delivering infrastructure pipelines as well as supervision of selected infrastructure projects;
- **Strategic reviews** – evaluating the merit of KIAT projects and management structures in achieving intended outcomes and recommending improvements;
- **Training** – across a range of relevant fields including infrastructure planning and delivery, civil society, financial management, risk and safeguards compliance.

## Types of contracts awarded

KIAT awards a variety of contracts to best deliver and meet the needs of our Government of Indonesia partners. Contract opportunities are available to individuals, small groups of individuals, small businesses and firms, as well as grant arrangements for research partnerships between Australia and Indonesia and grants to local NGOs located in Indonesia.

## KIAT's work streams



### TRANSPORT

KIAT's transport work stream focuses on institutional strengthening activities to improve road network development, management, and urban mobility. This includes working with government on: transport policy development, network planning and programming; systems for the management and maintenance of the existing national and sub-national road network; and improving data collection, scoping and feasibility studies for network expansion.



### WATER AND SANITATION

KIAT's water and sanitation work stream focuses on activities to improve the delivery of water and sanitation services and strengthen approaches to the management of solid waste. This includes activities to trial performance-based grants with sub-national Governments to incentivize network expansion and performance improvements with water utilities; as well as analysis for policy-makers on institutional options to consolidate regional and national management of water resources.



### GENDER EQUALITY & SOCIAL INCLUSION / CIVIL SOCIETY ENGAGEMENT

Infrastructure projects often focus only on the technical issues, disregarding social impacts and assuming that men and women automatically benefit equally. Equally, they ignore how infrastructure may be accessed by disabled and other vulnerable groups. KIAT works with government partners and civil society to help strengthen dialogue and ensure that infrastructure meets the needs of all citizens.



### INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCE & PRIVATE SECTOR ENGAGEMENT

In coordination with other donors working on the same cross-cutting issues, KIAT is helping to identify opportunities that promote private sector engagement in infrastructure financing and delivery. This includes working closely with national and local governments to provide technical assistance for the preparation of outline and final business cases for private sector participation.

## Current opportunities

### DETAILED ENGINEERING DESIGN OF MALANG CITY SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

KIAT is supporting the Indonesian Ministry of Public Works and Housing to implement a loan-funded investment in the solid waste sector through the design of a new state of the art sanitary landfill. All land acquisition, environmental impact assessments and permits are in place, and the site has passed the Government's loan readiness screening criteria.

A Detailed Engineering Design Consultant will undertake the following tasks:

- Review existing feasibility studies for the project completed, under separate World Bank support;
- Conduct additional geotechnical and topographic surveys as necessary;
- Develop Detailed Engineering Designs for the project landfill site including the landfill cells, leachate treatment systems and associated site infrastructure;
- Draft tender documents including BOQ, technical specifications, and drawings to meet World Bank and Government of Indonesia standards.

### PERFORMANCE BASED GRANTS PROGRAM FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE

KIAT is helping Government of Indonesia to roll out a performance-based grant program to maintain and rehabilitate Provincial and District roads.

A Program Implementation Consultant will help local Governments undertake maintenance works, including:

- Conducting road condition surveys;
- Preparing annual work plans;
- Reviewing engineering designs prepared by local consultants;
- Reviewing and updating procurement systems;
- Assisting with supervision and monitoring of works.

A separate Verification and Technical Assessment Consultant will assist Central Government departments to:

- Assess existing institutional performance;
- Verify the quality, quantity and performance of provincial/district road maintenance works to confirm they meet standards.
