# International Development Projects

## **Pacific Sports Partnerships (PSP) II - Australian Sports Partnerships Program – DFAT**

- 10 countries in Asia and the Pacific, 15 Australian sporting partners

## **Water for Women – DFAT**

- Partnering with 10 Civil Society Organisations and multiple research organisations to deliver 19 WASH projects in 16 countries in Asia and the Pacific

## **Transport Sector Support Program Phase 2 (TSSP II) – Papua New Guinea, DFAT**

- Planning and implementation of a stronger transport sector to enable economic growth and market access

## **M&E House ‘Buka Hatene’ – Timor-Leste, DFAT**

- Monitoring and evaluation program focused on community capacity building

## **Ebeye Water and Sanitation Project – Ebeye, Republic of Marshall Islands, ADB**

- Access to clean water and safely managed sanitation services

## **Pacific Aviation Investment Program –Pacific Region, World Bank**

- Implementing aviation upgrades in Pacific countries through multiple phases. Phase 1 included Kiribati, Tuvalu and Tonga.
