

INTERNATIONAL FREIGHT ASSISTANCE MECHANISM

INBOUND FLIGHT SCHEDULE AS AT 16 MAY 2022

The Australian Government's [International Freight Assistance Mechanism](#) (IFAM) is a temporary measure to help restore critical global supply chains which have been heavily impacted by COVID-19 containment measures around the world. IFAM keeps high-value, time sensitive and perishable exports and vital imports, such as medical supplies and other essential items, flowing so we can resume servicing existing supply contracts with their international customers.

The following information outlines the inbound charter flights supported by IFAM at the time of publishing and are subject to change. Recently updated information is highlighted in **purple**.
