	The total cost of external (domestic and off-shore) legal services in 2022-23 was \$563,865, a decrease of 51% from 2021-22. Demand for legal services is driven by operational business requirements and special projects; last year's costs are down as programs ceased as did implementing the International Network Optimisation strategy and registration of Nation Brand trademarks (twice). In addition, more work was performed by Austrade's internal legal team. Costs of running an internal legal unit decreased 44% year-on-year to \$655,582 with vacancies and cessation of locum lawyers providing assistance to specific programs and projects. The internal cost of the unit is comparatively low compared to similar sized agencies. This model (small internal staff with capacity to buy-in services) allows Austrade to flex up for external expertise when required while maintaining a low fixed cost presence.
